manufacturer, is placed into an aluminium frame. By doing

this, the producers can also accommodate their own wood

colours and thus selectively capture the colour of the

furniture again in the Light board. In this way, the modular

system specifically adapts to the design of the kitchen and

meets all the requirements of modern comfort.

Screws, angle brackets and the light source are mounted

in such a way that they are not visible from the outside. A
