The new "LichtBox": Minimalism with maximum

effect

The new "LichtBox" is based on the minimalist structure of

the company's Lighting System 4: a rectangular black

aluminium profile frame with integrated LED lights at the

front and at the back. The sawn aluminium profiles, which

are connected to each other with corner profiles, make the

system extremely lightweight; it can therefore be used to

great effect anywhere in the home. "We design our products

in a way that means they can be used individually, rather

than for a particular purpose in a particular area," says

Thomas Ritt.

This is also revealed by another characteristic of the

"LichtBox": the profiles hold a glass shelf; the "LichtBox"

can therefore be used to display and highlight special objects.

On the one hand, the extremely bright and indirect lighting

lights up the back wall. On the other, the precious objects on

display in the "LichtBox" are lit from the front. Whether a

vase, a sculpture or a flower arrangement – every object in

the box is staged to perfection with the aid of lighting. Just

extremely pleasant, very bright and at the same time quite

indirect light on the worktop. The "LichtBox" will be

available in the sizes 600 x 350 x 350 and 900 x 350 x 350

mm from the second half of the years onwards.

The "LichtBank" represents an additional further

development of Lighting Systems number 4 and 6. It can be

installed upright on a kitchen island and is also available as a

ceiling light. The shelf consists of a sheet of cut glass that

breaks the light upwards and downwards. Kitchen utensils

can be stored on the "LichtBank"; other utensils such as

whisks, sieves, soup ladles or wooden spoons can also be

stored below the shelf. GERA Leuchten will be presenting a

prototype of this piece of lighting furniture at the interzum.

Integrated light GLS 4: Turns the kitchen into a light

Another innovation that GERA Leuchten will be introducing

at the interzum is also based on Lighting System 4: the

dimmed integrated light GLS 4. The light, which measures 20

x 10 cm, is designed to be fitted to or inset into furniture in a

linear way. This results in an almost flush fitting light, for

example for the inside of a cabinet. In contrast to most of the

usually available solutions, the lighting provided by

integrated light GLS 4 is directed only inwards. "The lighting

system is a perfect example of the fact that we are not only

interested in the light as such but in the lighting result," says

Thomas Ritt. "In this case, the result is that that the lighting

is directed towards objects, rather than towards the user's

eyes."

The lighting mood is variable. The user decides via remote control whether the inside of the cabinet is lit up in warm or cool shades. Lighting control is essential, especially with regard to decors and different surface finishes. Certain surface finishes like concrete, for example, call for cool lighting, whilst others come into their own under warmer lighting. "This integrated light illustrates one of our objectives," says Hening Pölitz: "It is not the light source provides the lighting; the kitchen itself becomes the light."

The simplest ideas are sometimes the most brilliant. This

realisation definitely applies to the new pendant light 10

x 40. It is based on Lighting System 6 and is already on offer

upside down. The light emerges only from the narrow upper
